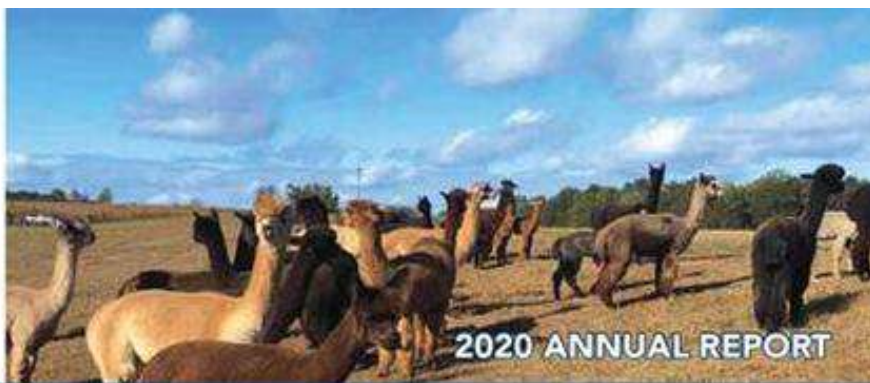

Next step: build our barn!

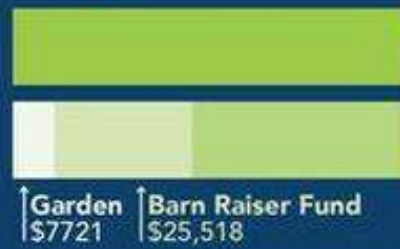
