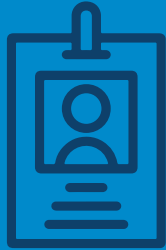

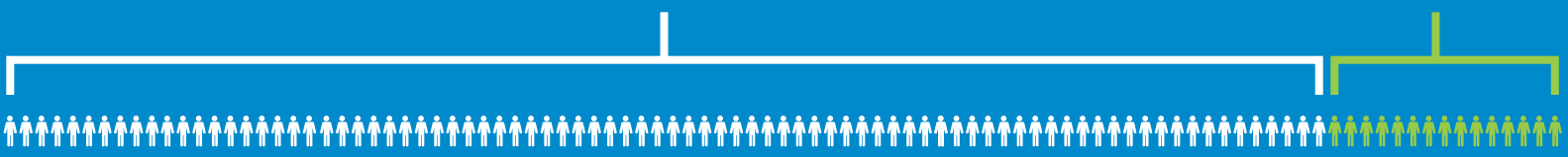
The Need

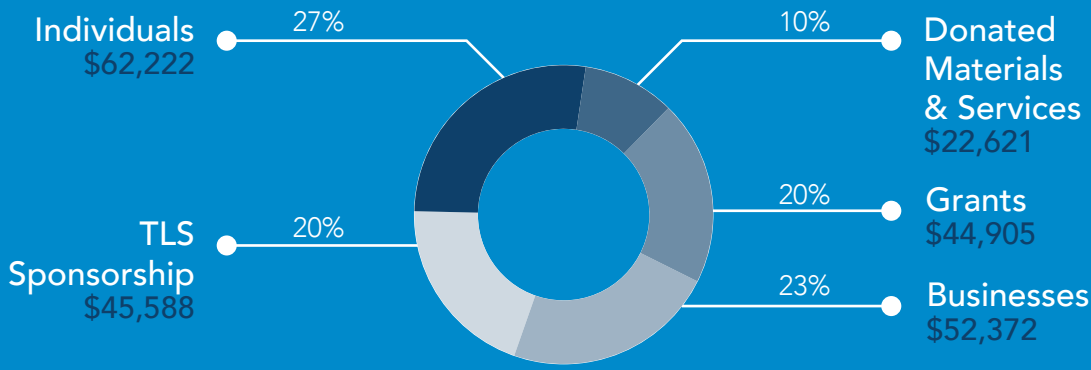


Thanks to **YOUR** support we built our alpaca barn this October!

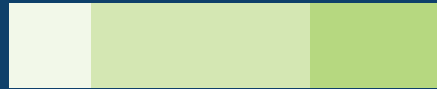

The kids strengthened job and life skills watering, weeding, harvesting veggies, cutting and arranging flowers, building raised garden beds and learning beekeeping.
