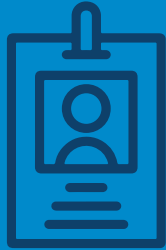

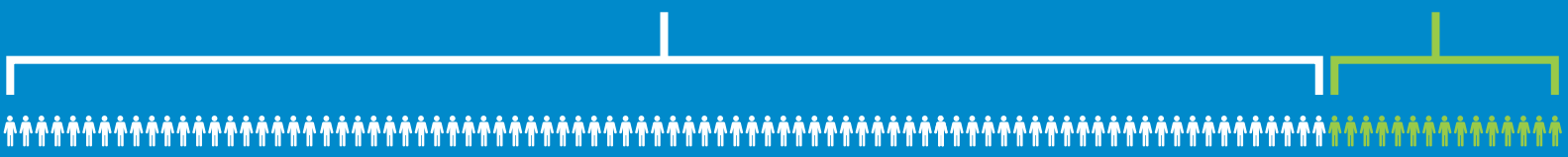
The Need

Our Mission

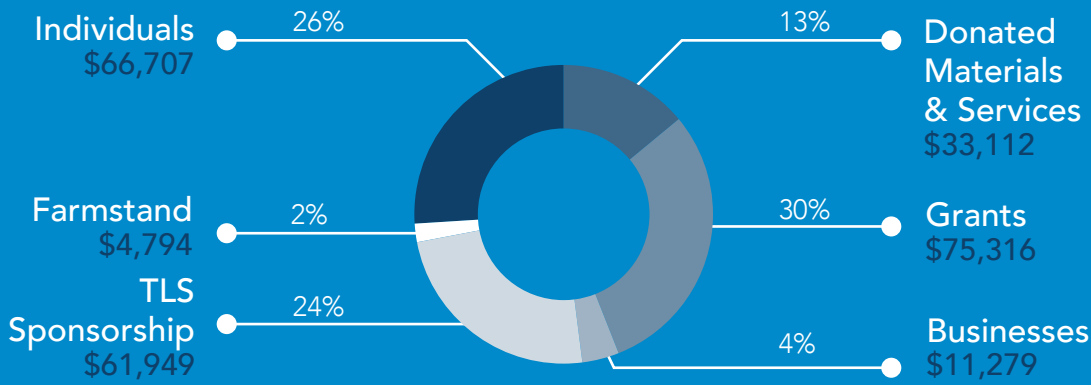
Provide quality training for young people on the autism spectrum to prepare for meaningful employment in the community.

Thanks to **YOUR support**, we're finishing construction on our farm and bringing in our alpacas this winter!



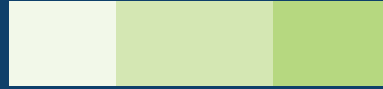

Thanks to our staff, students, volunteers and community partners (and lots of alpaca manure), in 2022 we added a new raised bed garden and a heated hoop house for season extension and harvested honey from our three beehives. The kids strengthened job and life skills watering, weeding, harvesting, building garden beds, beekeeping and selling veggies, flowers and honey at our student farmstand.
